Code of Conduct for Students

Christ Church College Kanpur has prescribed the following 'Code of Conduct' for students enrolled in the college:

1. Not smoke or chew pan in the College premises.
2. Not Park any vehicles in the College premises, but at the College stand only.
3. Always keep their Identity cards with them and shall produce them on demand by any member of the staff.
4. Not rag any student or misbehave with any staff member or defy the orders of the staff / officers on duty.
5. Not hold any meeting in the College without the permission of the principal.
6. Not skip their classes nor loiter about aimlessly in the College Campus. Shouting, talking loudly, and any vulgarity shall be considered as gross misconduct.
7. Not associate themselves with undesirable, outside elements nor invite them to the College Campus.
8. Not needlessly overstay in the College after their classes are over.
9. Not misbehave with the co-eds.
10. Not write on walls or disfigure desks, furniture or floor, or put unauthorized notices on blackboards or notice board.
11. Not leave class without the permission of the teacher.
12. Students should show respect towards National Flag, National Anthem, and National Symbols, etc. Students should exhibit and promote patriotism, nationalism, communal harmony, religious brotherhood and fellow feeling.
13. Under very compelling circumstances the College Management had to abolish the Students Union in the Year 2001-02, as specified in the '**Caution**' under the prescribed 'code of conduct' in the prospectus of the college.
