Policy on Internal Comprehensive Assessment and Evaluation

Weightage for internal and external evaluation is of the ratio 25/75 for all core and elective courses at UG and PG levels. The end-semester examination of the theory papers will be conducted by the university for a weightage of 75%. 25% of the internal theory marks have to be uploaded to the university portal.

All the practical components of the core and elective courses have to be evaluated at an internal level only by the college with a ratio of 25/75 for both mid-semester and end-semester examinations for uploading of marks at the university portal.

All the vocational courses have to be conducted in collaboration with the skill partners for both theory and practical components of the ratio of 40% for theory (01 credit) and 60% for practical (02 credits). But for evaluation of both the mid and end-term components, the same ratio of 25/75 has to be maintained for uploading marks at the university portal.

(A). All the faculty members and coordinators of vocational courses may maintain the files of internal evaluation of the theory of core/elective/vocational courses by adopting the following parameters for the break-up for internal comprehensive assessment:

- 05 marks may be allocated for attendance/class performance through quizzes, class seminars, etc.
- 10 marks may be allocated for mid-term written-examination
- 10 marks for written assignments/projects

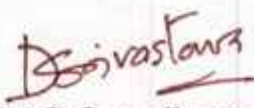
(B). For practical evaluation of all the courses (core/elective/vocational), the faculty members and the departments may devise the break up as per the nature of the courses and will have to include them in the lesson plan well in advance at the beginning of each semester. The students should be informed about the lesson plan well in advance.

(C). All the PG departments shall assign the projects as per the mandate of course curricula to each student of PG courses at the beginning of their first semester and evaluate them strictly as per university guidelines.

Please Note:

The departments shall conduct the internal mid-semester and end-semester examinations per the academic calendar schedule and maintain the internal evaluation files of all the papers, theories, and practicals. The coordinators of vocational courses shall also maintain the files of internal evaluation and shall follow the schedule of examination for the conduct of the examination.
