INSTITUTIONAL NORMS FOR POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH PROJECT EVALUATION

EVALUATION COMMITTEE COMPOSITION:

- The evaluation of the postgraduate project presentation and/or viva at the end of the Second Semester (First Year) shall be conducted by a committee comprising in-charge of the department, the project supervisors, and one internal expert from the same faculty of the college.
- The internal expert shall be approved by the Principal of the college to ensure credibility and impartiality in the evaluation process.

EVALUATION PROCESS FOR SECOND SEMESTER (FIRST YEAR) PG PROJECT:

1. The research supervisor shall assess 25 percent of the internal marks allocated for the project evaluation.
2. The remaining 75 percent shall be evaluated through an end-semester viva and/or presentation, conducted in the presence of an internal expert from the same faculty, as approved by the Principal.

EVALUATION PROCESS FOR FINAL YEAR PG DISSERTATION:

1. The evaluation of the PG Dissertation of the project for final-year PG students shall be conducted in the presence of an external examiner as per university guidelines.
2. The external examiner must be a subject teacher from a different college, approved by the university.
3. The evaluation process shall be convened and overseen by the internal committee of the department, ensuring adherence to university standards and guidelines.

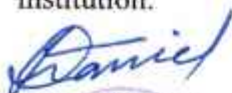
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE:

1. The evaluation committee shall meticulously assess the research projects based on criteria and standards set by the university and the college.
2. They shall provide constructive feedback to the students to facilitate their academic growth and improvement.
3. The committee members shall maintain confidentiality and impartiality throughout the evaluation process.

COMPLIANCE AND REVIEW:

- All faculty, staff, and students involved in the evaluation process must adhere to the institutional norms outlined in this policy.
- The policy shall be subject to periodic review by the college authority to ensure its effectiveness and alignment with university regulations.
