Under Graduate Admission: 2021-22

Semester System in Undergraduate Courses as per New Education Policy-2020 from the session 2021-22:

Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University (CSJMU) Kanpur and all its affiliated colleges including Christ Church College, Kanpur have adopted the Semester System in Undergraduate Courses as per directives of Higher Education Department, Uttar Pradesh to accelerate the teaching-learning process and enable vertical and horizontal mobility in learning from the Academic Session 2021-22.

The credit-based semester system will provide flexibility in designing curriculum and assigning credits based on the course content and hours of teaching. The common minimum syllabus has been approved and adopted by the University through the prescribed statutory process as per directives from UP Government.

The New System will have the following features:

- **1.** Academic Year: Two consecutive (one odd + one even) semesters constitute one academic year.
- 2. Credit System (CBCS): The CBCS provides choice for students to select from the prescribed courses (core, elective or minor or skill-based courses). Under the CBSS, the requirement for awarding a degree or diploma or certificate is prescribed in terms of number of credits to be completed by the students.
- **3.** Course: Usually referred to, as 'papers' is a component of a programme. All courses need not carry the same weight. The courses should define learning objectives and learning outcomes. A course may be designed to comprise lectures/ tutorials/laboratory work/ field work/ outreach activities/ project work/ vocational training/viva/ seminars/term papers/assignments/ presentations/ self-study etc. or a combination of some of these.
- 4. Credit Point: It is the product of grade point and number of credits for a course.
- **5.** Credit: A unit by which the course work is measured. It determines the number of hours of instructions required per week. One credit is equivalent to one hour of teaching (lecture or tutorial) or two hours of practical work/field work per week.
- 6. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA): It is a measure of overall cumulative performance of a student over all semesters. The CGPA is the ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses in all semesters and the sum of the total credits of all courses in all the semesters. It is expressed up to two decimal places.
- 7. Grade Point: It is a numerical weight allotted to each letter grade on a 10-point scale.
- **8. Programme:** An educational programme leading to award of a degree, diploma or certificate.
- 9. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA): It is a measure of performance of work done

ina semester. It is ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses registered in a semester and the total course credits taken during that semester. It shall be expressed up to two decimal places.

- **10. Semester**: Each semester will consist of 15-18 weeks of academic work equivalent to actual teaching days. The odd semester may be scheduled from July to December andeven semester from January to June.
- **11. Transcript or Grade Card or Certificate**: Based on the grades earned, a grade certificate shall be issued to all the registered students after every semester. The grade certificate will display the course details (code, title, number of credits, grade \secured) along with SGPA of that semester and CGPA earned till that semester.

Selection of courses and admission process for First Year of Under Graduate Programmes during the session 2021-22:

- The candidates will have to register first on the Admission Portal available on CSJM University Kanpur on its website for admission to any undergraduate programme running in the college. This is a pre-requisite as admission registration intent of the applicants for admission to any affiliated college.
- After successful registration at the CSJM University Admission Portal, candidates can apply for admission to the college on the admission link available on the college website: www.cccknp.ac.in. Candidates will have to enter the valid registration number of the university while applying to the college.
- Candidates will select the faculty where admission is sought (Science/Arts/ Commerce).
- Candidates thereafter will select the programme (B.Sc.-I/B.A.-I/B.Com.-I).
- Candidates will then select and fill their choices of their three Major Subjects.
- Selection of one Minor Course/Elective Paper will be open only after the admission is granted to the candidates. After the confirmation of admission to the college, candidates will be required to fill their choices of minor courses/elective papers online out of the list of courses available in all the subjects for both the odd/even semesters. As limited seats are available in each subject, allotment of minor courses/elective papers will be done on first come first serve basis.

Selection of Major Subjects/Papers:

- Candidates applying for admission to **B.Com.-I** will select three Major Papers from the Commerce Faculty.
- For Science Faculty, candidates applying for admission to **B.Sc.-I** will have two options to select from the group of three Major Subjects: (1) Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or (2) Botany, Zoology and Chemistry.
- In Arts Faculty, there are two faculty streams, (1) <u>Faculty Stream of Language Subjects</u> and (2) <u>Faculty Stream of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences subjects</u>. The candidates applying for admission to **B.A.-I** will select first the Arts Faculty Stream of their choice

and then select any two Major Subjects from the chosen stream. The chosen stream of first two Major Subjects will be called **<u>own</u>** stream and the remaining streams will be called **<u>other</u>** streams. The third Major Subject can be chosen either from own faculty stream or from the other stream of Arts Faculty.

Selection of Major and Minor/Elective Courses at Under Graduate level:

Selection of three Major Subjects:

- In Science and Commerce faculty streams, the candidates will have to choose all the three major subjects from their own faculty streams.
- In Arts faculty, there are two streams, (1) Language Subjects Stream, and (2) Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences Subjects Stream. The candidates will have to choose the first two major subjects from any one of the streams. The candidates choosing the first two major subjects from the stream concerned will be called their own stream. The third major subject can be chosen either from own stream or from the other stream of Arts Faculty.

<u>Selection of Minor Courses/Elective Papers:</u>

- The candidates of all faculty streams will have to select one minor course/elective courses of 4/5/6 credits in first year (odd or even semesters) and the other of 4/5/6 credits in second year (odd or even semesters). The selection of minor courses/elective papers have to be from the other stream only and not from own stream.
- In Arts faculty, the candidates can opt the minor courses/elective papers from the other/own stream of Arts faculty, Commerce faculty and Science faculty.
- In Science faculty, the candidates can opt the minor courses /elective papers from both the streams of Arts faculty and Commerce faculty.
- In Commerce faculty, the candidates can opt the minor/elective courses from both the streams of Arts faculty and Science faculty.
- Two minor courses/elective papers of 4/5/6 credits have to be completed in first two years (four semesters) only.
- As limited seats are available for minor courses/elective papers in the subjects concerned of the faculty streams, the candidates will be allowed to choose the minor courses and papers either in odd semester or even semesters.
- **B.Com.-I** candidates can opt for their Minor Courses/Elective Papers from the list of courses given either from Science Faculty Stream or from any of the two streams of Arts Faculty.
- **B.Sc.-I** candidates can opt for their Minor Courses/Elective Papers from the list of courses given either from Commerce Faculty Stream or from any of the two streams of Arts Faculty.
- **B.A.-I** candidates can opt for their Minor Courses/Elective Papers from the list of courses given either from any other streams (Commerce Faculty Stream/Science Faculty Stream) or from the other stream of Arts Faculty. But if the candidate chooses his/her third Major Subject from other stream of Arts Faculty and not from one's own, then he/she can select the Minor/Elective paper either from own faculty stream or from the other faculty streams.

Selection of Vocational/Skill Development:

- Each admitted student will have to opt for vocational courses of 03 credits in all the first four semesters as decided by the principal of the college.
- The admitted students will get the detailed information regarding the availability of **Vocational/Skill Development Courses** immediately after the confirmation of their admission in the college.

• Admitted students will select one Vocational/Skill Development Course and fill their choice ONLINE from the list of courses available in the college.

Compulsory Cocurricular Courses:

• Each admitted Undergraduate student will be required to qualify one **Compulsory Cocurricular Course** each for all six semesters.

Entry, exit and re-entry process in Undergraduate programme:

- Student on completion of first year (2 semesters) of Undergraduate programme may exit from the programme with a certificate and after completion of two years (4 semesters) may exit with a Diploma.
- Student will be awarded Degree after completion of three years (6 semesters).
- Student will be allowed re-entry at the next level after exit.
- Student will be allowed conditional subject change in the second/ third year on the basis of prescribed prerequisites and availability of seats
