ANNUAL REPORT OF ACTIVITIES IN COLLEGE SESSION 2020-2021

The College reopened on July 01, 2021 for the academic session 2020-2021 with **Secretary, Governing Body, Rev. Samuel Paul Lal** and **Principal, Dr. Joseph Daniel** addressing the Faculty and staff in the **College Hall** while strictly observing COVID protocols.

Apart from various other activities, Independence Day was celebrated with Chief Guest, Dr. Ripu Daman Singh. Regional Director, RHEO, Kanpur, under the convenorship of Mr. Niranjan Swaroop. Republic Day was celebrated with Chief Guest, Prof. Nand Lal, CDC Director, CSJMU Kanpur, and Guest of Honour, Rev. Samuel Paul Lal, Secretary, College Governing Body, under the convenorship of Dr. Z. H. Khan. NCC and NSS cadets with other students wholeheartedly participated in a true spirit of nationalism.

A Counselling session was scheduled for the freshers on 21st and 22nd September 2020. The session commenced with an inaugural blessing and address by the principal. The program on the whole helped the students to get acquainted with the college activities and functions of various cells and committees. The disciplinary committee convener advised the students about the rules and regulations of the college. Online classes started on 23rd September 2020 through the class link uploaded at the college web page. Students were encouraged to join the online classes on a regular basis and all measures were taken to mark the attendance on a regular basis.

ACTIVITIES BY THE FACULTY OF ARTS


