Institutional Policy on Divyangjan

The College is well aware of its role in providing necessary guidance and counselling to the students with Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan). In accordance to which, the college follows certain practices to support the Divyangjan students.

Objective:

To implement the various rights, regulations, scholarships provisions, facilities, opportunities laid down in Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, that prohibits discrimination against individuals with physical and mental disabilities.

Policies and Measures:

- 1. To provide equal educational opportunities to differently-abled persons in the Institute. A special reservation provision is provided by the college regarding their admission.
- 2. To create awareness about the specific educational needs of differently abled persons.
- 3. To create suitable regulatory mechanism for effective delivery of services to Disable Students and Staff of the college.
- 4. To provide fee concessions, assistance during examination, if required and other needs pertaining to differently-abled persons.
- 5. To assess their educational needs, determine and facilitate assistive devices that can be procured for them.
- 6. To facilitate scholarship.
- 7. To celebrate important days pertaining to disability such as the World Disabled Day, etc.
