The Women Cell of the college was constituted in 2016 to maintain a harmonious atmosphere to enable women students to pursue their work with dignity and reassurance. The Cell aims empowering and orienting women to recognise their true potential and to help them attain their own stand in the competing world of today.

The important objectives of the Cell are:

To mould potential women force in the campus to achieve thriving milestones of success, Empowering women to attain emotional, physical and mental freedom and strength to withstand the changing phase of their lives. To enhance self-esteem and quality of life and to eliminate the gender disparity especially in academic, official and house life.

The fundamental functions of the Cell are to safeguard the rights of female student, faculty and staff. The Cell also tries to incorporate hygiene habits and ensure a healthy atmosphere in and around the college.

To promote this noble mission, certain events like public lectures, career counselling, personal safety training programme etc. were organised in the campus.

Activities:

The students and female staff are well appraised of the effective implementation of the scheme launched by the Government of India – “*Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao*”. The Government of Uttar Pradesh through its Asha Jyoti Kendra gave various guidelines to the students through the cell. The **Toll-free no. 181, 0512-2303316, 1091, 100, 112** are given to girl students of the college to avail police assistance, legal, medical facility to launch complaints in case of need. *Rani Laxmibai Mahila Samman Kosh* Scheme by U P Government is for those girl students and women who are facing financial difficulties, women pensioners, women suffering from life threatening diseases. The cell upholds feminist ideals and opens up a space to discuss women's rights, equity, and social justice.

PROGRAMMES ORGANISED BY WOMEN CELL DURING LAST FIVE YEARS:

24th October 2016: Women cell organised a guest lecture on Gender Inequality by **Mrs. Neelam Chaturvedi, General Secretary of Sakhi Kendra and President of UP National Alliance for women.** 200 students participated in this. A campaign was organised by the cell to inform the girls students about the facilities provided by Asha Jyoti Kendra

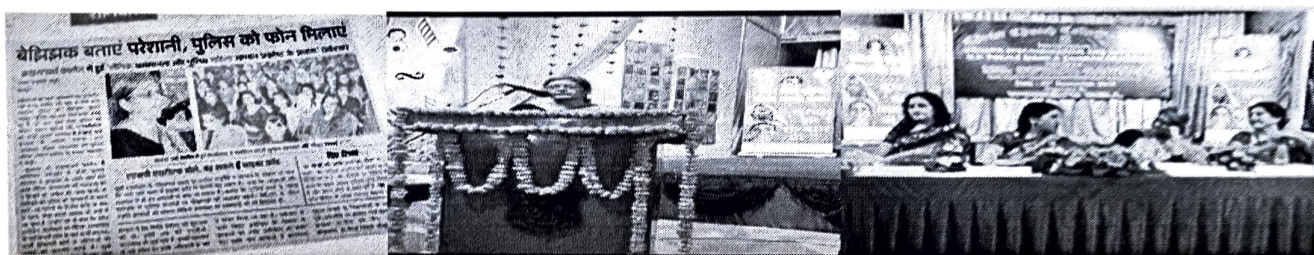

Kendra were put on various parts of the college. Students were well informed about the scholarships which they can avail.

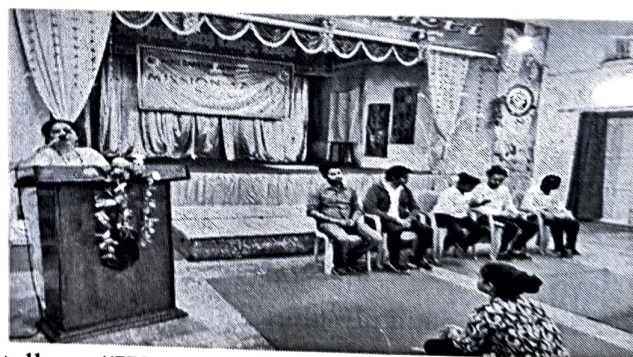
25th November 2016: Women Cell organised a guest lecture on Gender Discrimination and Efforts of UP Police Mahila Samman Cell by **Mrs Sutapa Sanyal, Director General UP Police**. Around 300 students participated in the programme.



22nd October -27th October 2018: “MISSION SAHASI”, programme to train the girl students for Self-defense which started on **22nd October 2018** and ended on **27th October 2018**. It was organized by **Women Cell, Christ Church College Kanpur** in collaboration with **Akhil Bhartiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP)**. This was a one-week workshop where our students were trained for Self-defense by a team of trainers from Lucknow. Various dignitaries visited the college during this workshop to encourage the students. **242 students** were enrolled in the programme. **83 students** completed the Self-defense course. The enrolment forms and the attendance of the students were collected by ABVP. The approximate percent of the students present daily were between 80 and 100. Assessment was made on the basis of attendance of students. They were also evaluated on the basis of techniques of Self-defense learnt by them.

The inaugural function took place on **22nd October 2018**. The convener of women cell Dr Shipra Srivastava delivered a small lecture on Self-defense training programme and introduced ABVP. The members of ABVP were introduced by **Mr. Sumit Kumar, Mahanagar Sangthan Mantri**. He highlighted the key features of the programme.

23rd October 2018 witnessed the enlightening talk on “Women Safety” by **Dr. Anoop Singh, Prant Adhyaksh, ABVP**. Next day there was a talk on “Women Empowerment” by **Mrs. Poonam Kapoor, member Mahila Aayog**. On **25th October 2018**, **Mr. V K Singh, Registrar, CSJMU Kanpur** delivered a talk on schemes of Higher Education.



Self-defense training was provided to the students by **Mr. Sumit Kumar, Mahanagar Sangthan Mantri** on **October 25 -26, 2018**.

The members included in the organising team from ABVP had Mr. Ramesh Gedia, Kshetriya Sangthan Mantri, Purvi UP, Dr Anoop Singh, Prant Adhyaksha and Mr Prashant Jha Tahseel Sanyojak.

The Sahasi Mission talked about a new perception of personality development amongst the students. It rendered confidence in girls and bolstered their hidden capabilities and capacity to protect themselves and be safe and secured in all types of environments.



18 September 2019: Workshop on Project Shakti means to encourage women empowerment by various techniques of martial arts. **Project Shakti was jointly organised by Women's cell, Mr. Aryan Shakya, a renowned martial art trainer and Aaj Prakashan Pvt Ltd.** To remove the gender disparity and to teach the girl students to fight against social



harassment and other wrong activities. The chief guest of the workshop was ADG Police Mr. Prem Prakash who encouraged the students for self-defense, safety and security. He also told students the importance of being strong morally. ADG Police Mr. Prem Prakash provided the helpline numbers of female police stations and the police. In his speech he motivated the students to be strong, capable and independent. 183 students participated in this workshop.

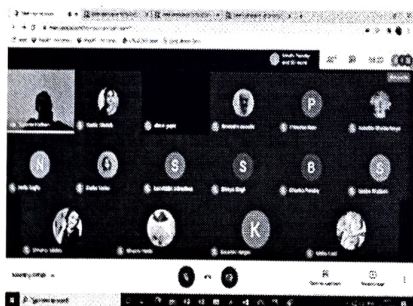

SUMMARY REPORT

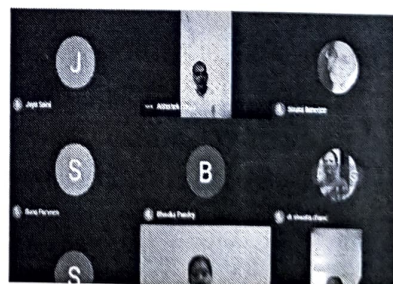

Christ Church College, Kanpur has been proactively engaged in taking up issues and concerns of women and empowering them to combat sexual harassment and gender discrimination, ensuring safety and security to women, so that they can walk with pride and confidence, at par with men in society. As part of its continuous activities, Women Cell Christ Church college has taken the initiative of organizing a **Self- Defence Training Workshop (17th to 25th October, 2020)** under the aegis and directives of UP Government's **Balika Suraksha Abhiyan**.



The Programme was inaugurated on 17th October, 2020 by offering prayers to the Almighty. The **Welcome Address** was delivered by **Dr. Joseph Daniel**, Principal of the college. Thereafter, **Dr. Shipra Srivastava**, Convener, **Women Cell** addressed the students and outlined the objectives and theme of the workshop.

This Nine-day **Physical Training Workshop on Taekwondo and Martial Arts** was conducted by **Mr. Prayag Singh**, National Trainer and Joint Secretary Taekwondo Association, Kanpur along with **Yashi Singh**. They imparted training on techniques of selfdefence used for Purse snatching /teasing and many more and laid stress on the pressure point attack for self-defence.

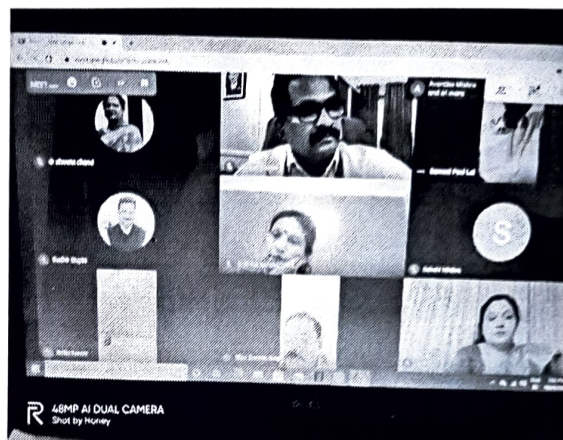


DAY 1 started with the encouraging talk by **Dr. Archana Pandey**, Associate Professor, **BND College** on **“Sashakt Nari, Sashakt Bharat”**, wherein she stressed the importance of women empowerment and informed the participants of the Helpline number for girls 1090/112.

DAY 2 witnessed the motivational address of **Prof. Soofia Shahab**, Chairperson ICC of the College. Prof. Shahab informed the participants about the aims and activities of the Cell and urged the girls to feel free to contact the cell in case of any problem they are facing. **Dr Sunita**

Rathore, Faculty of Law, Lucknow University, gave a talk on the legal scenario, regulations and Acts, POSCO and laws related to sexual harassment, eve teasing and domestic violence.

DAY 3 started with a motivational address by **Dr. Shipra Srivastava**, Convener, Women Cell of the College, who spoke about the relevance of the **Avatars of Shakti** during the auspicious festival of Navratri. Thereafter **Dr. Firdos Katiyar**, Associate Professor of the Botany Department, gave tips for a healthy and nutritious diet, particularly with reference to deficiencies and health issues of women.



DAY 4 witnessed the motivational address delivered by **Dr. Dorothy Rai**, Head, Department of English who talked about the dress code for girls while **Dr. Vibha Singh**, BHU, Varanasi gave a talk on health, “Amazing diet for Amazing youth”

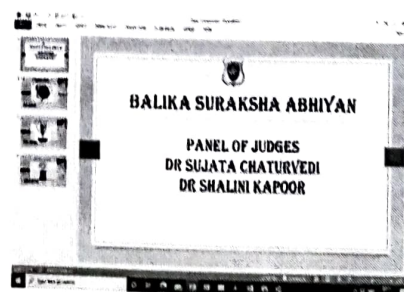
