WORKSHOP ON PROF. H.C VERMA'S ONLINE VIDEO COURSE ON "QUANTUM PHYSICS"

Under the BALSHALI (Bachelor Level Science in Hindi: A Learning Initiative) programme, Prof. H. C. Verma will commence his Online Video Course on Quantum Physics on 15th August 2019. A workshop for students of B. Sc. (Maths) and M.Sc (Physics) and M.Sc. (Chemistry) students was conducted in the college today. The objective of the workshop was to generate awareness about online courses which enable students to use technology to enroll for courses of their choice and at their convenience.

In his Introduction of the Workshop, **Dr. Rajesh Kumar Dwivedi**, Head, Department of Physics and Organizing Secretary (BALSHALI), underlined the importance of online courses as a powerful medium to reach out to the remotest corners and persons. **Dr. Sudhir Gupta**, Head, Department of Chemistry urged the students to enroll for this online course , which offers effective delivery and flexibility in learning .
