कानपुर 19 अगस्त भारतीय स्वरूप संवाददाता, क्राइस्ट चर्च कॉलेज परिसर में इमरटिकस लर्निंग के द्वारा “वॉक-इन ड्राइव” कार्यक्रम, महाविद्यालय के कैरियर काउंसलिंग सेल द्वारा आयोजित किया गया, इमरटिकस लर्निंग के सहायक उपाध्यय अभिषेक कुमार ने बताया “ कौशल आविष्कारों को पूरा करने के लिए मानव पूंजी की गुणवत्ता में सुधार करना आवश्यक है, उन्होंने बैंकिंग क्षेत्र में अवसरों के बारे में बताया और बैंकिंग क्षेत्र में जोखिम विश्लेषक के महत्व के बारे में बताया।
