Introduction

Christ Church College, Kanpur, is proud to establish the Ninan Abraham Lending Library and Research Section in honor of Dr. Ninan Abraham, our esteemed former Principal. The library serves as a valuable educational resource, providing access to a wide range of books to enhance the learning experience of our diverse student and faculty community.

Lending Library

Membership:

Membership of the Lending Library is open to all bona fide students of Christ Church College upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of Rs. 100/- per student per year. A separate Accession Register will be maintained for library members. Unique library cards will be issued to all members.

Borrowing Guidelines:

Members can borrow a maximum of four books every semester for the full semester. A maximum of one book per course can be issued to each member. Borrowed books must be returned before the commencement of exams, as failure to do so will result in the withholding of examination admit cards.

Operating Hours:

The Lending Library will operate during college working hours, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., on all working days.

Research Section

Membership:

Membership of the Research Section of the Lending Library is open to teachers and research scholars of Christ Church College upon payment of a deposit of Rs. 500/- per teacher/research scholar per year.

A separate Accession Register will be maintained for Research Section library members.

Unique library cards will be issued to all members of the Research Section.

Borrowing Guidelines:

Members of the Research Section may borrow a maximum of two books at a time, for a period of 15 days.

Habitual over-retention of books may lead to the suspension or cancellation of membership in the Research Section.
