The esteemed chief guest for the occasion was Ms. Supriya Pathak, an Associate Professor of the regional center of Mahatma Gandhi Hindi University, Wardha at Prayagraj.



The program was presided over by the Vice Principal of the college, Professor Sabina Ronica Bodra. The event commenced with a warm welcome by Srishti Mishra, a first-year student of BA at the college. Ms. Supriya Pathak began her speech by delving into the theme with a focus on nationalism. concluded by expressing her hope that the audience would benefit from the enriching discourse.


