Objectives of Mission Shakti:

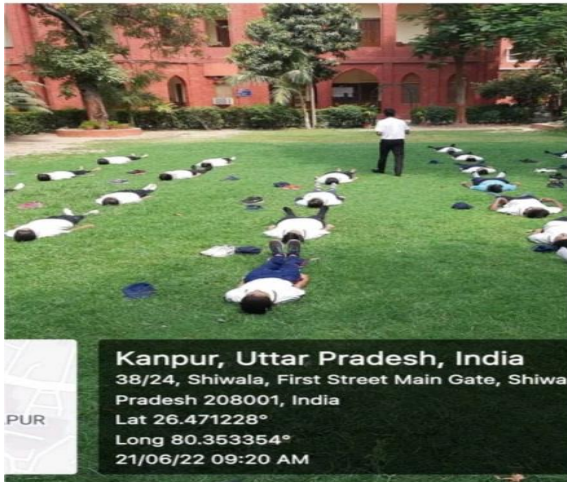
1. Provide immediate and comprehensive continuum of care, support and assistance to women affected by violence and for those in distress.
