Feedback Analysis Report



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

POST- ANALYSIS SUGGESTIONS AND ACTION TAKEN :

Suggestive Measures:

- 1. Library Resources to be enhanced for Students.
- 2. To enhance student teacher interaction.
- 3. Measures to be taken for overall personality development.
- 4. Complaints and grievances of students should be redressed promptly.
- 5. Internal Assessment System to be streamlined.
- 6. There should be more beyond classroom activities.

Action Taken:

- 1. Requisitions for purchase of books have been invited from all departments of the college. At the initiative of the IQAC a Lending Library is proposed in the upcoming session. Inflibnet access is available to all PG students and research scholars.
- The Mentor Mentee System has been improved by enhancing number of interactions with students and focusing on time-bound redressal of student concerns. Remedial classes are incorporated in Lesson plans of teachers to assist students.
- 3. Multiple platforms and programs are organised for holistic development of the students through NSS, Career Counselling Cell, Co-curricular Programs Committee etc.
- 4. Student Grievance Redressal Committee, Proctorial and Anti- Ragging Board and ICC adopt a proactive approach in easy access and redressal of student complaints.
- 5. The IQAC has chalked out the Continuous Comprehensive Internal Evaluation and Assessment Policy, which has been implemented to introduce transparency and plug any discrepancies.
- 6. Several departments have organised Field-trips, Industrial visits, workshops, seminars and presentations to augment the teaching-learning process.
