WEBINAR ON "RESEARCH IN ENGLISH STUDIES"


(30th November 2023)

Department of English, Christ Church College, Kanpur organized a Webinar on "Research in English Studies" at 05:00 p.m. on 30th November, 2023 on Google Meet platform. The resource person was Dr Fatima Noori, Assistant Professor at Department of English, Jagat Taran Girls' PG College, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj. The webinar was organised with the view of particularly helping the BA Final Year and MA (Previous and Final) students in undertaking their Research Projects effectively. The MA syllabus has a compulsory Course called 'Research Project' with 8 credits each in the first and second years. In the current session, there is also a newly introduced qualifying requirement of undertaking Research Project in the final year of BA for programme completion. Considering this, upon interaction with students, it was realised that most of them were unaware about the meaning, purpose, nature and processes of research. As an experienced academician who also remains up-to-date, Dr Noori shared her rich understanding of conducting research, and simplified the process.

Program Objectives:

- 1. Introduce the meaning, significance, purpose, and nature of academic research to students.
- 2. Acquaint students with the unique nature of research in English language and literature in comparison to other disciplines.
- 3. Provide students with a comprehensive understanding of various research methodologies and approaches used in English literature and language studies.
- 4. Develop students' proficiency in academic writing, focusing on the preparation of research proposals, literature reviews, and the articulation of research findings.

- 5. Remove the fear of undertaking research from the students' minds, and help simplify concepts and processes.
- 6. Orient students toward the path of conducting research with sound critical frameworks and ethical practices.



The online session was chaired by Prof. Joseph Daniel, Principal, Christ Church College, Kanpur. Ms. Shubhi Tiwari, Assistant Professor and In-charge, Department of English began by welcoming Prof. Daniel, the resource person, Dr Noori, faculty members and all participating students. She introduced the resource person to the attendees. Dr Fatima Noori is an Assistant Professor at the Department of English, Jagat Taran Girls' Degree College, a Constituent College of the University of Allahabad. She completed her PhD from University of Allahabad in 2018, and teaches English drama and poetry to undergraduate students. Dr Noori has been a Fulbright Doctoral Fellow in the session 2015-16 at Hamilton College, New York State University in Clinton, New York, where she worked on the archives of Kashmiri-American poet Agha Shahid Ali. She has several research papers to her credit in both national and international journals. She has also contributed a chapter to UGC's E-Pathshala program on Women Victims and Kashmir. Her research interests include diaspora literature, Indian poetry, Memory and trauma narratives.


Dr Noori's explanations about prevalent research methods, methodologies and use of available resources proved practically applicable for the students. Her illustrations of current examples from the field, as well as reference to the recent trends in research in the area of English language and literature proved useful for the students to navigate their research. At the conclusion of Dr Noori's presentation, some students asked questions and shared difficulties which the resource person efficiently addressed. Prof. Daniel expressed the need for such a webinar and its utility for the participating students. There were a total of 68 students in attendance, including BA Third Year and MA students. 


Program Outcomes:


- 1. Students were familiarised with basic concepts in research.
- 2. Students were introduced to new and emerging areas of research.
- 3. They were given practical tips to select a suitable research topic.
- 4. Students gained a clear understanding of how to design and plan their research projects effectively, including formulating research questions, hypotheses, and selecting appropriate methodologies.
- 5. Participants learned about various research methodologies applicable to English and how to apply these methods to their research projects.
- 6. The webinar provided insights into academic writing best practices, helping students improve their ability to write coherent and structured research papers and reports.
- 7. Students also got an overview of the prevalent citation styles in English Studies.
