2. Study on the level of awareness on mental health issues among women.

This study aims to determine level of awareness among the women about the mental health issues they are facing in their lives. Moreover, this study includes the responses of 30 students of Christ Church College, Kanpur.

The study reveals that 26% of the females have been diagnosed with a mental health condition such as stress, anxiety, depression, etc. Out of the total females, 40% do not feel comfortable discussing their mental health concerns with their family members and friends. 62.5% females who have been suffering from mental health issues have not sought a professional help to overcome these issues. More than 75% of the respondents are satisfied with the efforts made by Mission Shakti Unit of Christ Church College, Kanpur and are hoping that there could be more initiatives taken by them in near future which are helpful for them.
