### **Proposed Activities for the Session 2023-2024:**

The club proposed to organize a lecture series titled "Aprajita: Sahitya Ke Avismaraniya Stree Charitra" over the course of the current and the following academic sessions. The lecture series aims to invite eminent writers, scholars and literary personalities to share their views and interpretations of particular inspirational women in literature.

# Report on

## LECTURE ORGANIZED BY THE LITERARY ACTIVITY CLUB

(06<sup>th</sup> September 2023)

The Literary Activity Club of Christ Church College organized the inaugural lecture of a proposed lecture series titled "Aprajita: Sahitya Ke Avismaraniya Stree Charitra (अपराजिता: साहित्य के अविस्मरणीय स्त्री चरित्र) on 06<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.

# **Program Objectives:**

- 1. To create awareness about historical and contemporary inspirational women and recognise their contributions.
- 2. To learn about unforgettable literary representations of inspirational women.
- 3. To understand the influences behind these literary representations by prominent writers and scholars.
- 4. To gain a platform to interact with prominent writers and scholars.



The event was organized in Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Auditorium of Christ Church College at 11 am, and was attended by college faculty members, staff and students. The guest speaker for the program was Mr. Akhilesh, eminent Hindi fiction writer and editor of the literary journal, *Tadbhav*. The lecture session was chaired by Prof. Joseph Daniel, Principal, Christ Church College. Prof. Sabina Bodra, Vice-Principal, Christ Church College, and Mr. Avadhesh Misra, Coordinator, Literary Activity Club were other members on the session panel. Manvi Shukla and Harshita Arya, students of BA (Final Year), moderated the session. The program began with a formal welcome of the guest speaker. Prof. Joseph Daniel felicitated Mr. Akhilesh by presenting him with a plant sapling. Then Mr. Arunesh Neeran Shukla, Assistant Professor, Hindi Department, introduced the topic of the lecture series. Mr. Avadhesh Misra shared the proposed plan of the lecture series and introduced the guest speaker. This was followed by the insightful lecture delivered by Mr. Akhilesh, who shared his experiences and thoughts on writing about women characters who influenced him. Following this, Dr Nazir Husain Khan, Assistant Professor, Urdu Department, shared his observations and comments on the lecture. Mr. Arunesh Neeran Shukla then opened the house for discussion. Several students and faculty members in the audience put forth their thoughts on the lecture and asked pertinent questions to Mr. Akhilesh, resulting in a thoughtprovoking conversation. The Vice-presidential address was delivered by Prof. Sabina Bodra who shared her experiences and brought up relevant questions about women empowerment for the audience to reflect upon. Mr. Akhilesh was then presented with a memento by Prof. Bodra. Finally, Ms. Shubhi Tiwari, Assistant Professor, English Department, concluded the session with a formal vote of thanks.

### **Program Outcomes:**

- 1. The audience gained newer perspectives on the myriad manifestations of women empowerment
- 2. Students and faculty members in attendance were introduced to the writings of a prominent contemporary Hindi author, Mr. Akhilesh
- 3. Students learnt about the factors influencing a literary work and were inspired to engage in literary pursuits
- 4. Students and faculty members utilized the opportunity to interact with and learn from an eminent Hindi author.

# Report on LECTURE ORGANIZED BY THE LITERARY ACTIVITY CLUB (23<sup>rd</sup> September 2023)

The Literary Activity Club of Christ Church College organized the second lecture of lecture series titled "Aprajita: Sahitya Ke Avismaraniya Stree Charitra (अपराजिता: साहित्य के अविस्मरणीय स्त्री चरित्र)) on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2023.



Even today Sita is being kidnapped. The second lecture of the "APRAJITA" series organized by Literary Activity Club Christ Church College Kanpur on the topic of unforgettable female characters of literature was held on 23/09/2023 in Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Auditorium. Professor of Urdu at Aligarh Muslim University and renowned ghazal writer Professor Syed Sirajuddin Ajmali was present as the chief guest to speak on this topic.

The program was presided over by the Principal of the college, Professor Joseph Daniel. Dr. Nazir Husain Khan, Assistant Professor of the Urdu Department, delivered the welcome address threw light on the personality and work of Mr. Ajmali.

Professor Ajmali presented his views on the subject in the context of Sita Meer Chandani, the heroine of Quratul Ain Haider's novel Sita Haran. He not only underlined the presence of period element in Haider's novel structure but also discussed in detail how women became the biggest victims of violence during Partition. He also pointed out that

even today Sita is being deceived and kidnapped. Patriarchy has deceived them most in the name of love. Professor Ajmali also recited his ghazal on this occasion.

Commenting on her statement, the convener of the Literary Activity Club Mr. Avadhesh Mishra said that if the decision had been in the hands of women, partition would not have happened. Underlining the horrors of partition through writings in Bengali, he said that men were accepted in the society but women, victims of the violence of partition, were



neither accepted in the society nor at home. Therefore, we have to read their expression or resistance afresh. Professor Zafar also made a very meaningful comment on Professor Ajmali's statement. Vice Principal Professor Sabina Bodra, in her statement, strongly advocated women's independence, education and their economic self-reliance.

In his presidential address, Professor Daniel said that it feels good to hear from such scholars. We have to respect women's struggle and resistance and also walk step by step with them. Their struggle is our struggle too. There were numerous question and comments from student in this interactive session. The chief guest was honored by the Principal by presenting him a memento. The formal vote of thanks was given by Yusra Khan, a BA student. The program was successfully conducted by Al Shifa, a BA student. A large number of teachers, teaching staff, students and researchers were present during this important program.

concluded by expressing her hope that the audience would benefit from the enriching discourse.


