Minutes of the Meeting

Date: 30/09/2023

The Students Grievance Redressal Committee meeting was held on 29/09/2023 to discuss on the INTERNAL ASSESSMENT related issues of the students.

Meeting Agenda:

Consideration of students with genuine reasons for re-tests, late submission of assignments, and other assessments at the departmental level as per the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) procedure as a pre-measure for avoiding students' internal assessment related grievances.

Discussion Points:

- 1. The committee discussed the need to address the grievances of students who, due to genuine reasons, were unable to appear for class tests, quizzes, or submit their assignments on time.
- 2. It was noted that the current CIA procedure requires continuous evaluation, and accommodating such students would ensure fair and equitable assessment.
- 3. Various measures were proposed, including allowing make-up tests, extending assignment deadlines, and providing alternative assessment methods for students with valid reasons.

Decisions Taken:

- 1. The committee unanimously decided to give a representation to the principal, requesting that departments be directed to consider cases of students with genuine reasons for missing assessments.
- 2. The representation will highlight the importance of these measures in reducing student grievances and ensuring fair evaluation.

Gist of Student Grievances during the session
